Commonly Asked Questions:

- Q: What is a "Drug Free" jobsite?
- A: A "Drug Free" jobsite has drug testing requirements written in the specifications which require the contractor to test the workforce on that job.
- Q: How do I participate in the program?
- A: You must get an initial program test at:
 - * An Approved Collection Facility
 - * A Local Union Hall Group Testing
- Q: If I miss a group testing, am I out of the program?
- A: No, schedule an individual test by contacting your local union's Third Party Administrator.
- Q: How will I know when my annual test needs to be renewed?
- A: You will receive a letter from the IMPACT Program Coordinator with specific instructions on how to update your test.
- Q: How do I schedule an appointment with an approved collection facility for a test?
- A: Contact your local union's Third Party Administrator for a listing of approved facilities and assistance with scheduling.
- Q: What happens if I fail a test?
- A: A non-negative test is reviewed by the MRO. After the result is confirmed, the IMPACT Program Coordinator will contact you with further instructions.


