To All Contributing Employers:

The Ironworkers Local 11 Benefit Funds and Training Facility issues BENEFITS for the payment of fringe benefits to Iron Workers working within the jurisdiction of the Ironworkers Local 11 Benefit Funds. Enclosed are the Schedules of Hourly Wage Rates and Fringe Benefits **effective July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026**. As an employer, you are required to purchase benefits for each of your ironworker employees, at a value equal to the **total hours paid**. Please be reminded that you may not give cash or checks to employees for fringe benefits. If any other method of benefit payment is used, it may be deemed to be a violation of the rules and regulations of the Collective Bargaining Agreement.

The new contract for **Period 49** begins on **July 1, 2025** and ends on **June 30, 2026**. The purchase price for benefits for **Period 49 Structural and Rebar, Fence & Guiderail** is the number of hours times the **hourly fringe benefit rate of \$51.87**. A breakdown by Fund is as follows:

Please also be reminded that there is a **4% ASSESMENT OF BASE WAGES AND PER CAPITA TAX (.25 Structural, .24 Rod) THAT MUST BE DEDUCTED FROM THE IRONWORKERS**. Weekly Hours Reports should be submitted and fringe benefit purchased each week for that week's payroll. All fringe benefit contribution amounts and wage rates are effective as of **July 1, 2025**.

Example: Structural Journeyman Hourly Base Wage $\$52.24 \times 4\% = \2.09 , Rebar Journeyman Hourly Base Wage $\$49.94 \times 4\% = \2.00

Under Section 302(C)(5)(B) of the Labor Management Relations Act of 1947 and confirmed by *Moglia v. Geoghegan*, there must be a written agreement with an employer before fringe benefit contributions can be made. Therefore, you will be required to sign such an agreement before fringe benefits may be purchased.

Please note that all checks submitted for the purchase of fringe benefits should be made payable to **"Ironworkers Local 11 Benefit Funds"**. A service fee of \$30.00 will be charged for any check that is returned by the bank. Any employer that has a check returned for insufficient funds will thereafter be required to purchase fringe benefits with a Certified or Bank Check.

5. 10% premium is included in the Foreman wage rate and 20% premium is included in the Lead Foreman wage rate.
6. An Assessment of 4% of base wages (e.g: *Journeyman hourly rate*\$52.24* .04 = \$2.09) and Per Capita Tax of \$.25 will be deducted per hour paid after deductions and included in the benefit payment.

5. An Assessment of 4% of base wages and Per Capita Tax of \$.24 for Rod/ Fence & Guiderail and Per Capita Tax of \$.25 for Structural will be deducted per hours paid from base wages and included in the benefit payment.

ASSESSMENT AND PER CAPITA TAX DEDUCTION

The work assessment deduction is to be calculated at 4% of the **base wages**. Base wages is to be reported along with the hours on the report form and in the portal.
